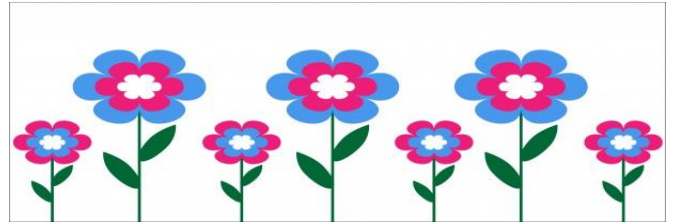
Northlake Sunday School Kids
