FROM THE DESK OF MARCHELLE KNAPP

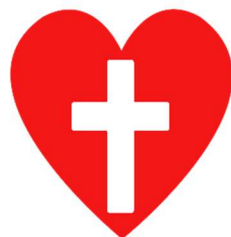
Well here we are in the heat of the summer. Hopefully you have been able to keep cool.
